- c) passed the Parkland Chemistry Competency Test OR
- d) completed BIO 121 (Anatomy & Physiology) and/or the equivalent course at another institution (including a cadaver lab—except for Respiratory Care) within the past five (5) years.

⁶ For the Dental Hygiene program: You have

- a) completed BIO 121 (Anatomy & Physiology) within the past five (5) years *and* have taken a chemistry course within three (3) years OR
- b) completed an equivalent course to BIO 121 (Anatomy & Physiology) *and* chemistry at another institution (including a cadaver lab) within the past five (5) years.

⁷ For the Massage Therapy program: You have

- a) completed BIO 111 (Intro to Anatomy & Physiology) and/or the equivalent course at another institution (including a cadaver lab) within the past five (5) years. *Note:* BIO 111 online or hybrid courses are not accepted.
- b) no math (MAT) requirement.

⁸ You have taken the COMPASS Assessment Test for Reading and are reading at college level (scored at least 83).

⁹ You have an ENG 101 (English) placement OR passed ENG 99 with a B grade.

¹⁰ You have taken Parkland's COMPASS Assessment Test for **math** and received a placement in
